Dear Parents (Pre-Nursery to XII),

Recently, we have noticed a few cases of conjunctivitis (commonly known as pink eye) among some of our students. Conjunctivitis is a highly contagious eye infection that can spread rapidly among children in close contact. To ensure the well-being of all our students and staff members, we earnestly request that if your children are suffering from conjunctivitis, kindly do not send them to school until they have fully recovered. Keeping an infected child at home helps prevent the spread of conjunctivitis to other students and staff.

Symptoms of Conjunctivitis:

- Pink or redness in the whites of the eyes.
- Watery or thick, yellowish discharge from the eyes.
- Itchy and irritated eyes.
- Swelling of the eyelids.
- Sensitivity to light.
- Crusting of eyelashes, especially in the morning

If your child is experiencing any of the symptoms mentioned above, please consult a healthcare professional immediately for proper diagnosis and treatment.

Furthermore, we kindly request you to encourage your child to practice good hand hygiene by washing their hands frequently with soap and water, especially after touching their eyes or face. Additionally, please advise them not to touch or rub their eyes and to refrain from sharing personal items such as towels, handkerchiefs, or eye drops with other students to avoid cross-contamination.

Your cooperation and vigilance in this matter will be highly appreciated.
