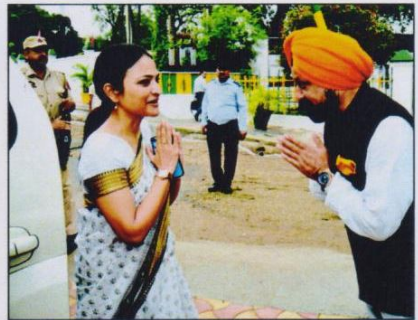
Earlier, a mesmerizing dance performance 'Ājab kiya singaar bhawani' depicting

Further, students also actively participated in Inter School Hindi Diwas competition and activities and brought laurels to the school.

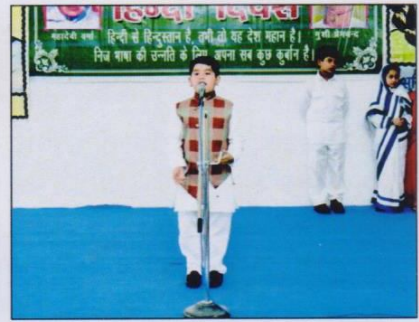
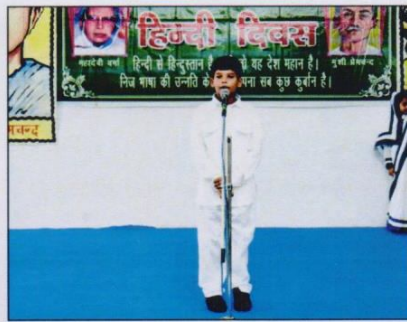
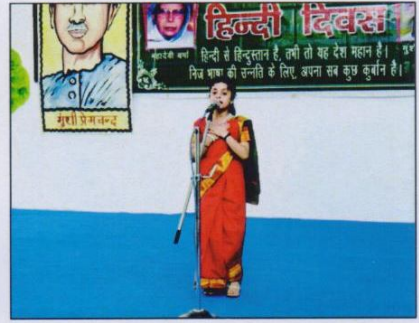
