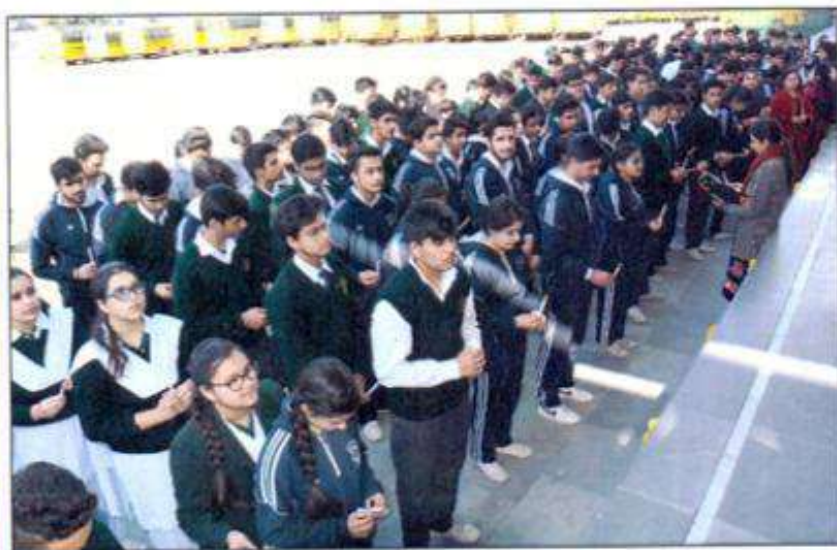








## DELHI PUBLIC SCHOOL, JAMMU ORGANIZES BLESSING CEREMONY FOR CLASS X

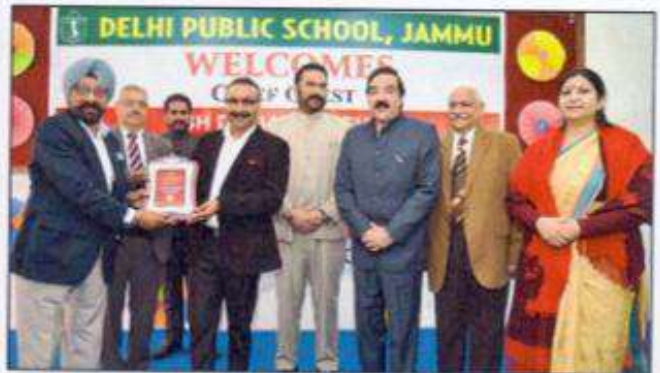
He also felicitated meritorious alumni and shooters of DPS Jammu along with all members of J&K Rifle Association. He

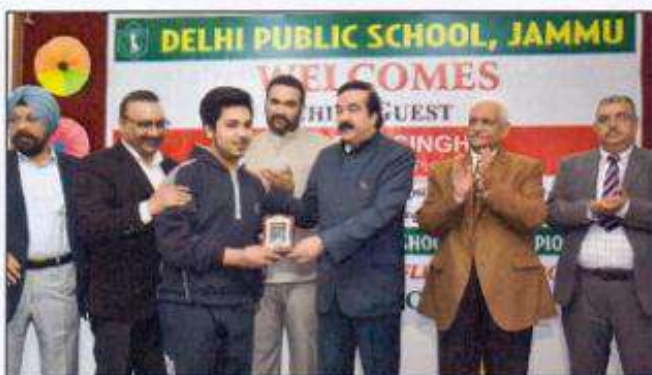

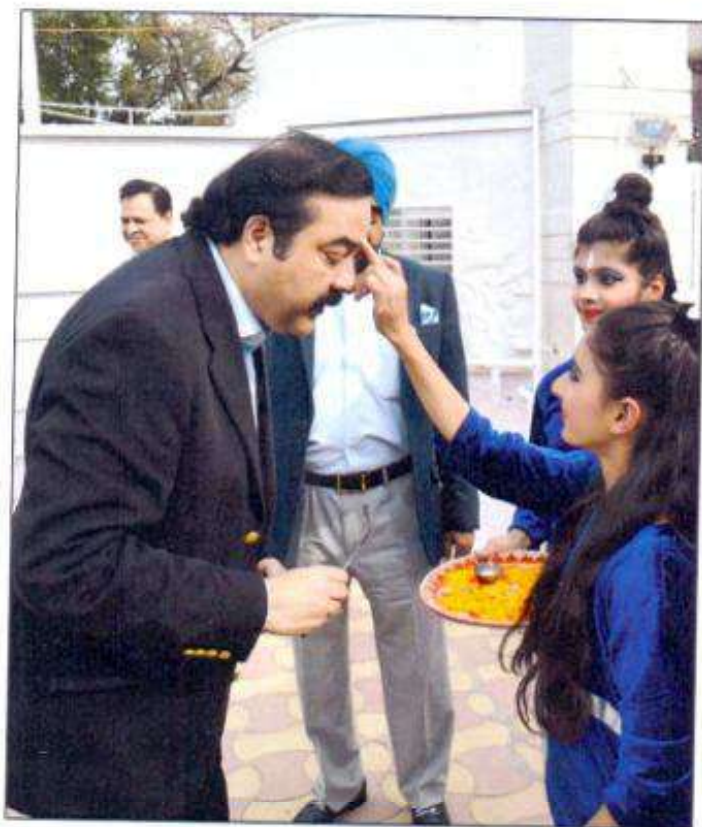








## 9<sup>TH</sup> J&K STATE RIFLE SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP CONCLUDES AT DPS JAMMU

## DPS JAMMU ALUMNI CRACKS CHARTERED ACCOUNTANCY EXAM-2018



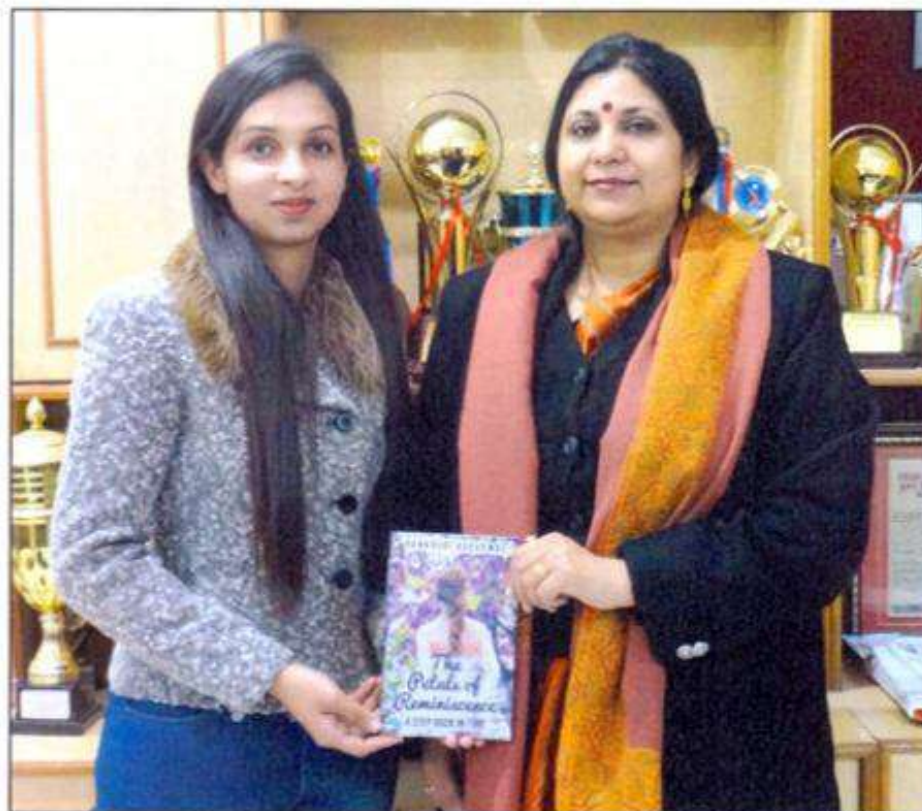

Pankhuri is a Gold Medalist in English Literature. She has completed her M.Phil and is currently pursuing her Ph.D in English Literature from University of Jammu.

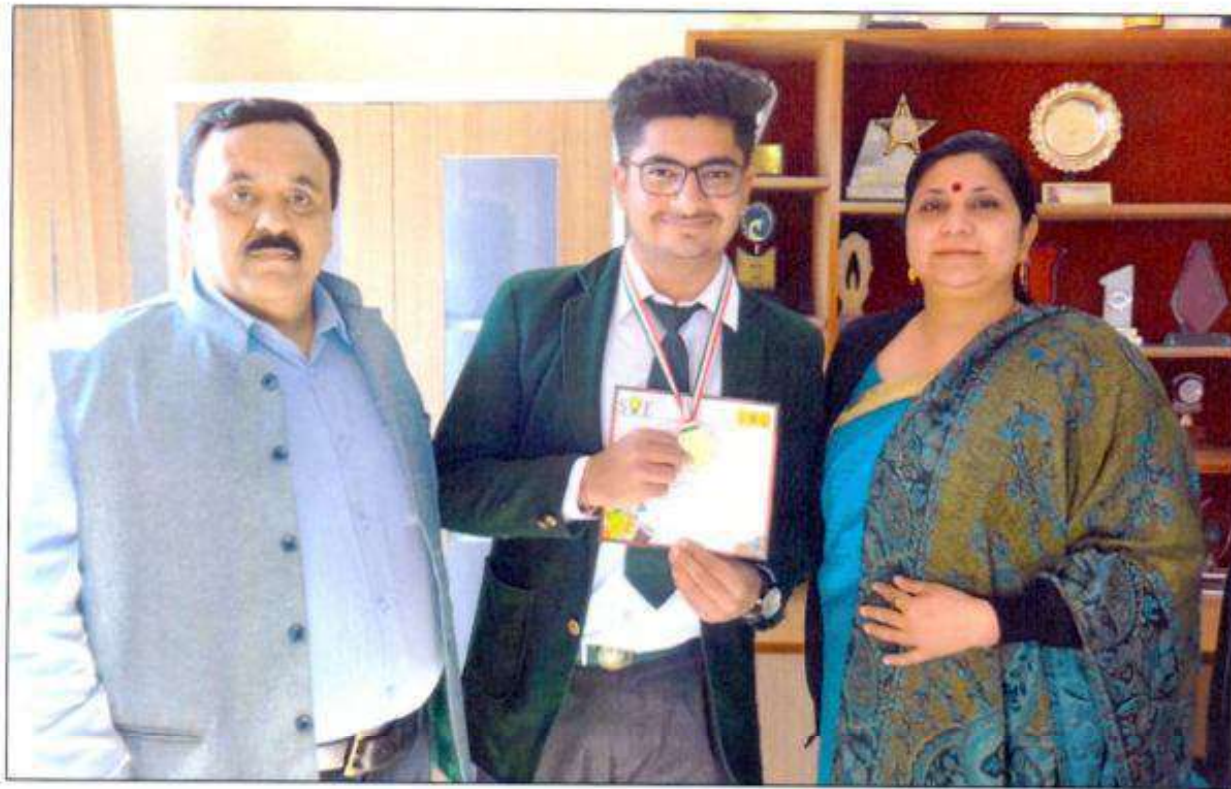
