Dinosaurs are known for their adaptations that helped them thrive in different environments. Herbivores

had specialized teeth for grinding plants, and many developed defensive features like horns or armor.

Carnivores, on the other hand, had sharp teeth and claws to hunt their prey. Some dinosaurs were bipedal,

walking on two legs, while others were quadrupedal, using all four legs for locomotion. Fossil evidence

has also shown that many dinosaurs had feathers, and some could be warm-blooded, showing more

similarities to birds than reptiles.
