Case Study

Q10. Read the extract and answer the questions that follows Case Study :

The Harappans had good relations with their neighbouring civilisations. They had a flourishing internal as well as external trade. Occurrence of Harappan artefacts found outside the Harappan region and of foreign objects within the region points towards existence of long distance trade. Silver, tin, gold, copper and precious metals were brought from outside, perhaps from Persia, Mesopotamia, Afghanistan and Oman. Discovery of Mesopotamia cylindrical seals from Harappan cities and Harappan seals from the cities of ancient Mesopotamia. Gold could have come from present-day Karnataka and semi precious stones from

present day Gujarat, Iran and Afghanistan. A dockyard excavated at Lothal gives a clear hint of the overseas trade.
