Northern plains lie to the south of the Himalayas. These are also called the Indo Gangetic Plains. This is the most extensive and fertile region of the Indian subcontinent. It is fertile because it is made of fine soil called alluvium brought down and deposited by many rivers. These plains stretch about 2,400 km from Punjab in the west to Assam in the east. Their width vary from 150 to 400 km. These plains are the most densely populated regions of India. Three main river basins are located in the Northern plains. They are : (1) the Indus Basin (2) the Ganga Basin (3) the Brahmaputra Basin.
