The other purpose of the ICC is to educate people-to teach them how carelessly thrown trash can cause harm and result in the death of marine animals. Another purpose of the ICC is to put pressure on the government and international bodies to take steps and implement rules in order to protect marine life. This act of putting pressure can be in the form of a letter or a poster campaign to support laws to punish those who are responsible for pollution.

The ICC was started in 1986. Since 1997, in the Philippines, it has grown from a few hundred years to an outpouring of thousands in dozens of cities, towns and villages. The volunteers not only remove the trash, but also identify and record it. These are then studied to pinpoint the sources of marine pollution.
