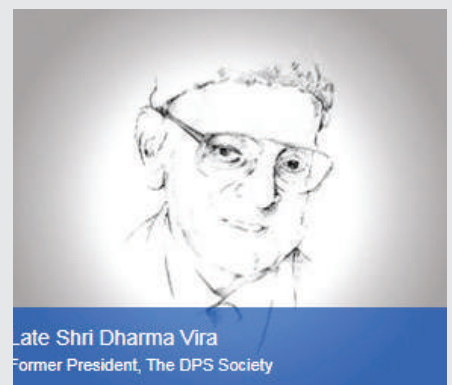
Late Shri J.K. Chowdhury

- Received Padma Shri Award in 1977 for professional excellence.



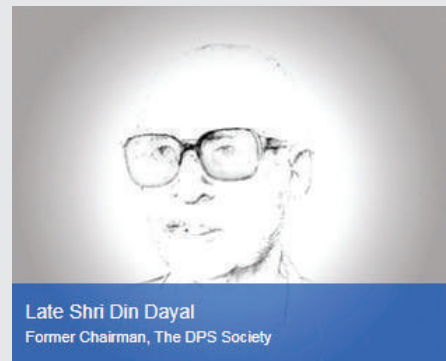

- Awarded Padma Shri in 1970.



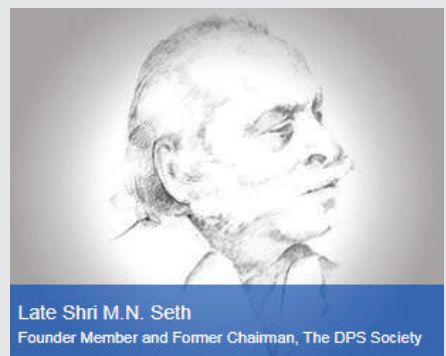
