

ADMISSION POLICY FOR CLASSES PRE-NURSERY TO IX (SESSION 2024-25)

Delhi Public School Jammu will advertise in the leading daily newspapers for online/offline admission in classes from Pre-Nursery to IX during the month of January, 2024.

On receipt of requisite forms duly filled in online/offline by the parent/their guardians, requisite online entrance test will be conducted by the school during the month of February, 2024 for Classes I to IX for the purpose of selection of the students on the basis of their merit and available vacancies in the school.

No entrance test will be conducted for admission in classes Pre-Nursery to Prep. However, these students will be admitted after very normal oral interaction in presence of the parents through offline mode.

After declaration of the result, admission will be granted to the successful candidates during the month of February/March, 2024 for the session 2024-25.

In case the school requires to admit more students, a 2nd entrance test for the students will be conducted by the school during the month of March, 2023 as per the similar procedure detailed above and admission will be granted to the successful candidates on the basis of their merit and the vacancy with the school.

Admission Policy for Class XI (2024-25)

1. INTERNAL CANDIDATES

Admission to Class XI is seamless and automatic. However, final streams will be allotted according to the final Board result in May/June, 2024 (Tentative). Before that, Provisional allotment of streams will be done based on the marks scored in the two pre-boards. For final allocation of the streams, Students need to attend final Counseling cum Admission session on the prescribed dates along with the print out of their marks card (Offline mode). For final allocation of the streams, Students need to attend final Counseling cum Admission session on the prescribed dates offline along with the print out of their marks card (Offline mode). The criteria for stream allotment shall remain the same as informed earlier.

2. EXTERNAL CANDIDATES

There will be No Provisional Admission granted to External Candidates. The admission process will begin after result declaration in May, 2024 (tentative) and shall open in case of vacancy with the school. It will include the following:

- a. Application along with CBSE Class X Marksheet.

b. Registration

c. Aptitude Test (offline) for shortlisted candidates.

d. Interview/Counseling with the selection committee

Eligibility Criteria:

Commerce and Humanities Stream: Aggregate 85%, English, Science & Mathematics 85%
Science Stream: Aggregate 90%, English, Science & Mathematics 90%.

The candidates not fulfilling the eligibility criteria will not be allowed to appear for the Aptitude Test.

Aptitude Test: Syllabus will be based on CBSE Secondary School Curriculum (Class X) and will be held (offline) in the following subjects as per the stream opted by the candidates:

Science Stream: English, Science & Mathematics

Commerce Stream (With Maths): English & Mathematics

Commerce Stream (Without Maths): English, Science & Social Studies

Humanities Stream (With Maths): English & Mathematics

Humanities Stream (Without Maths): English, Science & Social Studies

The candidates shortlisted for interview/counseling will be telephonically informed about the date and timings for the same. The candidates have to appear for an interview/counseling along with their parents on the date and time notified

Result: The successful candidates will be telephonically informed on the next day.

Important Instructions:

a. Candidates to adhere to the Reporting time for Registration and Aptitude Test(offline).

b. The candidates not fulfilling the eligibility criteria will not be allowed to appear for the written test.

c. It is compulsory for each applicant to carry: Two passport size photographs, a copy of marks obtained in the Board Examination (as and when asked for)
